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OVERVIEW:

Students (using reading, writing, listening, speaking, and hands-on activities) will do the following:

1. Develop an understanding and appreciation of how artwork is made and why.
2. Create work in 2-dimensional and 3-dimensional forms.

GOALS:

Students will:

1. Safely use materials, techniques, and processes to communicate experiences and ideas.
2. Create and continue to develop a working portfolio that displays an understanding of the Elements and Principles of Design and control of materials.
3. Use the artistic process to plan, implement, refine, and reflect in the creation of 2-D/3-D work.
4. Create artwork with specific subjects and/or themes in mind, using symbols to enhance meaning.
5. Analyze and describe how personal experiences affect art or add value to the viewer's experience.
6. Compare and contrast Art created by different artists for different purposes (including personal experience).
7. Participate in and initiate positive discussions about artists, processes, and materials (including their relationship to historical or social influences).
8. Analyze and describe the relationship among the Arts and other subject areas.
9. Make aesthetic decisions in the selection and presentation of work for Fine Art Festival.
