RULES AND REGULATIONS

The theme for the Space Foundation 2014 International Student Art Contest is “My Spaceship Looks Like...” All artwork entries should address this topic in whatever creative way your students wish, as long as the final artwork meets size and acceptable artwork media/format guidelines, as described below.

STUDENT AND TEACHER ELIGIBILITY

The 2014 Space Foundation International Student Art Contest is open to students in eight age categories (ages 3 – 4, 5 – 6, 7 – 8, 9 – 10, 11 – 12, 13 – 14, 15 – 16 and 17 – 18). Limit of one entry per student. Each student (entrant) may submit one original artwork in any of the following acceptable media/formats: drawing, painting, mixed-media or digital.

IMPORTANT!

- All contest entries must be created by a student in the contest age categories.
- All entries must be submitted by a teacher. Public, private and homeschool teachers are eligible.
- Ideal artwork size – 18” x 24.” Artwork entries should be no smaller than 11” x 17” and no larger than 18”x 24”.
- All entries /artwork submissions must be in high-resolution digital format and uploaded to Artsonia.com, in digital format no later than noon Universal Time (12:00 UTC), November 15, 2013 (further instructions below).
